How to designate Darryl Chappell Foundation in your will

You can provide one final gift to Darryl Chappell Foundation by including in your will the following statement –

“I give to Darryl Chappell Foundation, a non-profit entity currently located at 909 New Jersey Avenue SE, Unit 412, Washington, DC 20003, or its successor thereto, ____ (written amount or percentage of the estate or description of property) for its unrestricted use and purpose.”

Designating Darryl Chappell Foundation as a beneficiary

An alternative to designating Darryl Chappell Foundation in your will is to designate Darryl Chappell Foundation as a beneficiary designation. You may find this approach to be easier and free (avoid potential attorney fees).

- Individual Retirement Accounts (IRAs) and other retirement plans
- Life insurance policies
- Annuities

Simply contact your financial institution via on-line or phone. Request a change of beneficiary form or complete a change of beneficiary form on-line. Determine what percentage (1% - 100%) you would like to designate for Darryl Chappell Foundation. Confirm with your financial institution that Darryl Chappell Foundation appears as a designated beneficiary, with the desired beneficiary percentage, after processing your request.
